KEYNOTE SPEAKER DHA BOARD OF COMMISSIONER TRINIDAD RODRIGUEZ



A Denver native, Trinidad ("Trini") Rodriguez is senior vice president, managing director, public finance at D.A. Davidson & Co. Mr. Rodriguez has been a public finance investment banker since 1999. In that time, he has structured and underwritten tax-exempt and taxable bonds to finance public and nonprofit issuers' capital and infrastructure needs.

Mr. Rodriguez's community leadership spans many organizations in Colorado. He currently serves as past-chairman of the Downtown Denver Partnership's Management Group and Denver Civic Ventures boards, chair of the board of the Colorado Fiscal Institute, and a trustee for the Rose Community Foundation, where he currently chairs the board development committee and has chaired the now discontinued education committee.

In 2019 he was appointed by Governor Polis to the Colorado Governor's Revenue Estimating Advisory Committee. In 2020, he was appointed by Mayor Michael Hancock to co-chair the Large Employers and Anchor Institutions committee of Denver's Economic Relief and Recovery Council. In the past he has served on the boards of the Urban Peak, Winter Park Recreation Association and New America School.

Mr. Rodriguez is also past-chair and current member of the Denver Housing Authority Board of Commissioners, for which he recently chaired the executive director search committee. He has served as a budget and finance committee chair and member of Transition Committees for then mayors-elect John Hickenlooper and Michael Hancock and Governor-elect John Hickenlooper.

Mr. Rodriguez currently resides in Denver with his wife Sarah, a physician, and daughter, Catalina, a Denver Public Schools senior.




